There are two types of voice communication provided by EPIC (Education Paging & Intercom Communications) System[™]: a single classroom two-way call ("intercom"), and a one-way "page" or announcement into a zone. If you can remember the phrase "touch and talk" you can call into any classroom or page any zone on campus. A zone can include a single area (e.g. a cafeteria), or multiple areas (e.g. all common areas), or an all page which would include every amplified room in the school.

Intercom and paging areas are displayed on the map and turn blue upon selection. To talk into a room, press the room on the map with your finger and it will turn blue. To talk into a zone, press the desired zone under "Zones" on the left side of the screen. All of the rooms in the selected zone will turn blue displaying where the page will occur.

After the selected area changes to blue, a green "Intercom" or "Page" button will appear on the right-hand side of the screen. The intercom or page will NOT occur until you touch the green "Intercom" or "Page" button. This allows you to change your selection without sending any audio over the system.

When the "Intercom" or "Page" button is pushed, a "Call is active" window will appear indicating that any sound picked up by the microphone in the office will now be heard in the selected room or zone. The green "Intercom" or "Page" button will change to a red "End" button. When finished, touch "End" to end the call.



Operating Tips

How to make a Page

Step 1 Under "Zones", select desired zone/area to page. This example shows "Entire School" being paged.Step 2 Press the green "Page" button and speak. Note: the highlighted areas on the map will receive audioStep 3 When finished press the red "End" button.



How to make an Intercom Call to a Classroom

Step 1 Touch desired area for intercom message. This example shows "Room 207" being selected. **Step 2** Then press the green "Intercom" button and speak.

Step 3 When finished, press the red "End" button.



Immediate Response and Action to a SAFE Alert

When a teacher activates a SAFE alert from their classroom, the following will occur:

- An alert attention signal will sound to draw your attention to the screen.
- A SAFE alert screen will pop up over your current screen, requiring your immediate attention.
- The room or area initiating the alert will be highlighted in red on the displayed map, indicating where to respond.
- If your school has cameras in each classroom, a "live view" video feed of the room will appear, allowing you to assess the situation.
- Text and email messages will be sent to the SAFE (Signal Alert For Education) System response group.

When a SAFE alert is activated, immediately perform the following steps:

Step 1 Press the "Acknowledge" button to signal back to the teacher that the alert has been received and acknowledged.

Step 2 Take all actions as outlined in the SAFE System Protocols developed and outlined by your school. *To see an image of a non-paired alert, please refer to page 4.



Note: SAFE System Training Recommended

In times of stress, the sudden release of adrenaline into the human body, can affect thinking and reasoning abilities greatly. The use of frequent fire drills help condition first responders to handle an emergency evacuation and allow them to respond to it, more or less, as if it was a common everyday event. When staff and students are trained for emergencies, everyone is familiar with the plan and how to conduct themselves during such an event. The training normalizes the event and conditions us with the appropriate response.

This same type of training and conditioning should be applied to SAFE System alert activations. All parties involved in responding to a SAFE System alert should be trained, rehearsed, and practiced in their roles according to the response protocols developed and established by school administration.

Frequent training in responding to a SAFE alert event will provide the response team with the self-confidence and skills needed to respond appropriately even when the adrenaline is flowing.

Non-Paired Alert

If a teacher activates a SAFE Alert when away from their room, the microphone will use any other nearby systems to alert the EPIC System and display the teacher's approximate location. This is referred to as a "non-paired alert". Follow the same steps for a non-paired alert as you would for a paired alert.



Ending the Event

Step 1 An authorized member of the SAFE alert response team, with appropriate credentials, press the "End Event" button.

Step 2 Make a comment to document the incident and press "Submit."

Activate a Notification

The system administrator has programmed EPIC System with a number of different audible notifications. The manual sounding of a class change bell is one example of them. You may activate the bell notification throughout the school at any time regardless of the programmed bell schedule. Activate this and other notifications by following instructions below.



Step 1 Press the "Notifications" Icon 🜵 to display the "Notifications" window

Step 2 Now that the "Notifications" window is displayed, you can press any of the available icons for desired notification announcement. To have a bell ring immediately, press the play button next to the "Bell" icon **1**. Another box will appear on the screen with the option to start or cancel. Now press the "START NOTIFICATION" button to ring the bell. This reassures you that EPIC System has sounded the bell throughout the school. **Executive Summary**



Step 3 Stop notification – In some cases the notifications will play on a loop. Once the signal has been sent and should be stopped, click the STOP Button next to the notification to end the notification. You can follow the previous instructions to start another notification. Once you are finished sending your notification(s), you can return to the main Map screen by pressing the "Home" button.



General Information on the notifications window. This window allows the user to activate pre-recorded notifications to the school. The notifications shown below may or may not be programmed into your school's system. Applicable notifications are determined by your administrators. This window shows notifications that may be available to you. They are activated in the same manner that the "Bell" notification is activated e.g. select the desired notification and then press the green "START NOTIFICATION" bar.



To immediately stop any or all notification or bell, press Stop All button 🖲 in the left-hand panel.

Select a different "Bell Schedule" for the day

The system administrator has programmed EPIC System with a number of different bell schedules for different types of days. Day types could include schedules for "A" or "B" days, "Assembly", "Late Start", "Snow", "Early Out" days, or more.

At times it may become necessary to change the bell schedule from one type of day to another.



Step 1 Press the "Calendar" icon **m** to display the "Schedule" window.

Step 2 Locate the calendar day you wish to change and touch that day. A box will be drawn to outline that day. If you accidentally touch the wrong day, touch it again and the box outline will be removed. In the example below, December 4th has been selected to change the day type. Its "Day Type" is currently "Monday and Wednesday."



Step 3 With the calendar selected, as indicated by the box outlining the date, you are now free to touch the new day type desired. Since we are changing this from a "Monday and Wednesday" day type to a "Late Start" day type press the "Late Start" title. The color of the box surrounding the 4th should change from the "Monday and Wednesday" index color to the "Late Start" index color indicating a successful re-assignment of the day type.

View Device Status

If a room or area is not functioning as expected, the user may notice a room has turned yellow. This indicates that the device is not online. Contact an administrator!



The first thing for administrators to check is whether those devices are online. Click the settings icon ***** to view all devices. There will be a red, yellow, or green dot. Red signifies offline, green is online, yellow is online but some core function isn't working. Hover over the yellow for more information. If there is a red dot, attempt to navigate to or ping the IP address. If it is not responding, there is an issue with the device or network and it will need to be inspected and troubleshot. Offline device emails can be sent to an administrator to ensure devices are operational. Additional details can be found in the administration technical manual.

Guide to EPIC (Education Paging & Intercom Communications) System[™] Alerts and Notifications

The following provides the Alert and Notification actions available to a school district when utilizing the EPIC System. It should be used as a guide when discussing and evaluating what a district would like to have happen upon the initiation of an Alert or Notification within the EPIC System.

Definitions:

- SAFE (Signal Alert For Education) Alert A SAFE Alert is an action initiated by 1. A press
 of the alert buttons on the teacher's microphone, 2. A press of the red alert button
 physically installed on the classroom wall, or 3. A press of the alert button on the EPIC
 System[™] Teacher Interface, which is the web page a teacher can log into within the EPIC
 System. Alerts are actions that notify the front office, or other personnel that assistance is
 needed in a particular area of the campus.
- Notification A Notification is an action that is initiated from the main screen of the EPIC System web interface or Console, OR an action that is initiated from a signal from an external system. (i.e. the buildings access control system sends EPIC System a signal which then EPIC System is prompted to play the 'Lockdown' Notification Message). Notifications are actions that send out a notification alerting the entire campus that there is an emergency, or that action needs to be taken.
