## REMOTE VOLUME CONTROL OF MICROPHONES

## XD TEACHER MICROPHONE (OWN) LEVEL ADJUSTMENT

Press either the *UP* or *DOWN* arrow button to increase or decrease the volume level of the Teacher Microphone. A *green* LED over the OWN (for own microphone) will flash with each press.

The SELECT button determines which level will be controlled by the UP/DOWN buttons.

## XD STUDENT MICROPHONE (OTHER) LEVEL ADJUSTMENT

To adjust the XD Student Microphone (OTHER) volume, first press the *SELECT* button so that the LED over the *OTHER* label comes on. Now press the UP/ DOWN buttons to control the level of the OTHER microphone.



### **TURNING ON DEVICES**

To turn on the XD Solo, flip the *switch* on the back of the device to the *On* position. The battery indicator lights to the left should be illuminated.



To turn on the XD Teacher Mic, press and hold the *PWR/MUTE* button until the *BATT* indicator light glows green. To turn off the XD Teacher Mic, press and hold the *PWR/MUTE* button for approximately three seconds or until the *BATT* indicator light turns off.



#### **WIRELESS AUDIO PAIRING**

- 1. Press the *power/MODE* button to activate the *Wireless Audio* function. Press the *power/MODE* button again to turn the Wireless Audio function off.
- **2.** When the Wireless Audio function is activated successfully, the screen will show "Wireless Audio Disconnected", then it is ready to pair.
- **3.** Activate the Wireless Audio connection on any Wireless Audio capable device.
- **4.** Find the device name "TQ8" on the pairing list to connect the device.
- **5.** When the paring is successful, the speaker will emit a tone and the screen will show "Connected."
- **6.** The speaker is ready to stream audio from the device.
